

## *Shooting in Park Manor*

Area One detectives investigate shooting in Park Manor

One woman suffers a graze wound; one woman killed

CHICAGO—Area One detectives are on high alert on this Tuesday morning as they investigate the death of one woman and three wounded victims on the South Side in the Park Manor neighborhood. Police said that around 1:30 a.m. a gunman started shooting at two women sitting in a parked vehicle on the 6500 block of South Calumet Avenue, the Chicago Tribune reports.

A 25-year-old woman suffering from a shotgun wound to the head was taken to University of Chicago Medical Center, and later pronounced dead at 1:50 a.m., according to Cook County medical examiner's office. The other victim on scene, a 35-year-old woman who refused treatment at the scene of a graze wound to her back is in stable condition.

Sources say that there were two men who were standing on the sidewalk at the time of the shooting. A 21-year-old man who suffered a gunshot wound to the left ankle, and another man, age unknown, who refused treatment at the scene for a graze wound to the hand. University of Chicago Medical Center released a statement that listed both men in good condition.

Police said that the gunman approached the vehicle on foot. The Park Manor investigations of the shooting are ongoing. Police have yet to neither apprehend any suspects nor have authorities release any information on the gunman to the public. As of now the woman who has been killed as of Tuesday morning has not been identified according to the Chicago Tribune.
